VEHICLE ACCESS POLICY

The following rules apply from April 27th to July 1st outside of Festival operating hours.

0. **Leave Room!** - Do not pull up too close to any vehicle in front of the gate. In case the vehicle is not permitted to enter it will need to back up and turn around.

1. **Drive-on Passes** - Drive-on pass must be displayed on vehicle for access to village from April 27th – July 1st. The purpose of drive on passes is to limit the number of vehicles in the park at one time, to prevent traffic clogging.

2. **Number of Passes Per Group** - Drive-on Passes are issued to each guild, group or booth depending on location. Generally only 1 pass is issued per guild, group or booth.

3. **Drop Off Passes** - Management maintains a total of 3 "Drop Off" passes that can be used for drivers who are only dropping off or picking up and then immediately leaving. They are valid for 30 minutes. Name, location of drop off, cell phone number, and some form of collateral (such as Driver's License) must be given to receive a Drop Off pass.

If all Drop Off passes are in use and you do not have a Drive-on pass, then you will be required to wait outside the village until the next Drop Off pass becomes available.

4. **Speed Limit** within the village is 5 miles per hour. No exceptions. This is for safety and to control dust.

5. **Avoid Parking in Village** - We ask that Participants only park in the village if they absolutely need to. Please load/unload and park outside the village if you can, so we can maintain optimum traffic flow.

6. **One Way Roads** - The following roads in the village are listed as 1 way ONLY, unless your vehicle cannot safely fit through the appropriate entrance/exit road.

From the LORE Building to the Amphitheater, the Main Thoroughfare is labeled an "Entrance" road, meaning it can only be used to drive further into the village. It cannot be used to return to the gate.

From Ship of Games to the the Gazebo near the LORE Building, the back road is labeled an "Exit" road, meaning it can only be used to exit the village or drive toward the front gate.



7. Parking In Village - For One way Roads, parking must be done on one side of the road only. On the Entrance road vehicles must park on the left. On the Exit road, vehicles must park on the right side of the road.

Regardless of where you are in the village all vehicles must be parked in such a way to allow other cars, emergency vehicles and trucks with trailers to pass through. This is primarily for safety so emergency vehicles can easily access any part of the park if there is an accident or fire. Secondly this makes it easier for vehicles trying to move through the park.
