Koroneburg Renaissance Festival returns to Corona, CA with new attractions

Corona, CA – Koroneburg Renaissance Festival is once again opening its doors for five weekends starting May 25 through June 23. This is the third year under new management for Koroneburg Renaissance Festival, featuring new growth and entertainment as the most interactive Renaissance experience in the Corona, Eastvale and Norco communities.

- The **Knight's Castle**, erected at the end of the village.

Koroneburg Renaissance Festival begins May 25 and runs on consecutive weekends until June 23, including Memorial Day. The festival is open rain or shine on Saturdays from 10 am to 7 pm and Sundays/Memorial Day from 10 am to 6 pm. The festival is located at Riverview Recreation Park in Corona, CA.
